BID SPECIFICATIONS

The following specifications are for any bidder who is interested in purchasing real estate owned by the City of Portland and located at 510 S. Bridge Street, Portland, IN 47371 which is formerly the Sheller Globe Manufacturing Plant. The legal description is attached. All bidders must comply with the following specifications.

- 1. Provide the following information for the bidder:
 - a. Name of bidder
 - b. Primary address of bidder
 - c. Name of contact person including address and telephone number
 - d. Net worth of bidder on January 1, 2022
- 2. Provide written business plan that outlines the use of the building, timeline for renovations and your estimate of your cost to make the renovations.
- 3. The business plan should include your intended use of the buildings, the area where the buildings are located and the vacant land behind the buildings.
- 4. The number of jobs which will be created in the first year upon completion of renovations and on the fifth year thereafter.
- 5. The successful bidder must bid no less than the appraised value of the real estate which is \$46,000.
- 6. The successful bidder must sign a purchase agreement for the amount of the bid and pay (with check) ten percent of the purchase price as earnest money at the time the bid is received.
- 7. Payment of bid balance is due upon closing of the sale.
- 8. A Performance Bond in the amount of the bid must be submitted at the time the bid is awarded.
