

§ 71.07 TRUCK REGULATIONS.

(A) No person shall drive or operate, or cause to be driven or operated any truck upon the streets, bridges, and culverts within the city, except on designated and marked city truck routes as described in Chapter 74, Sch. XI.

(B) The restrictions as herein set forth on trucks shall not be applicable to trucks delivering or picking up goods and property at places not located on designated and marked city truck routes, provided such trucks are only operated by the shortest way possible between the designated and marked city truck route and the place of delivery or pickup or as otherwise directed by a police officer. The restriction is not applicable to refuse or garbage trucks regularly operating within said city while in the process of picking up refuse and garbage from the residences and business places within the city. ORDINANCE NO. 2023-2

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 71.07 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Portland, Indiana that Chapter 71.07, Truck Regulations, is hereby amended to add the following section:

Section 71.07 Truck Regulations

(c) Penalty For Violation of Section.

Any person, firm, or corporation found in violation of this section shall be fined in the sum \$275.00, in addition to the court costs, for the first such violation. Each subsequent violation shall be assessed a fine of \$500.00 in addition to the court costs. Notwithstanding this penalty provision, the City shall maintain the right and ability to pursue a separate civil action to collect actual damages, caused to roadways, curbs, sidewalks, or other personal property by any person, firm, or corporation found in violation of this ordinance.

All other provisions not amended hereby shall remain in full force and effect.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Common Council of the City of Portland, Indiana on this 20th day of March, 2023.

With this ordinance being published for public notice on April 7, 2023, the penalty for this ordinance will go into effect on April 17, 2023.
